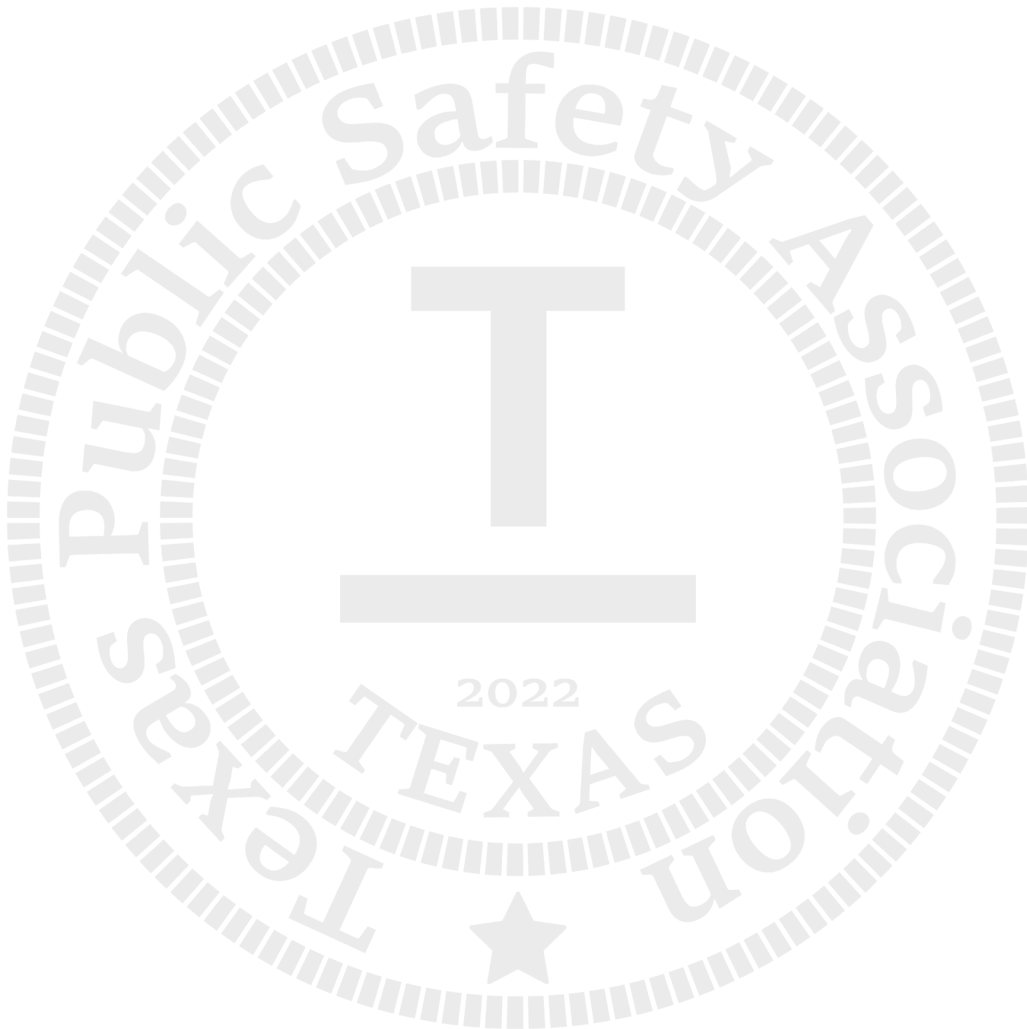

Here's the latest from our side:

- **Dry Cleaners:** Scene contained. No additional injuries reported.
- **Subway Sandwich Shop:** All injured have been triaged; scene remains secured.
- **Sherwin Williams/Meth Lab:** Fire still spreading into adjacent businesses; perimeter expanded and additional units deployed.
- **Casualties:** Confirmed fatalities now total 12 with 15 patients treated across scenes.
- Witness reports continue to suggest a suspicious figure near the scenes.

Hi Jordan,

Here's our current update:

- **Dry Cleaners:** 3 patients treated on scene; no new cases.
- **Subway Sandwich Shop:** 5 patients; 2 remain in critical condition and have been transported to City General. 2 fatalities have been confirmed at the scene.
- **Sherwin Williams Site:** 7 patients treated, with 4 in critical condition. 3 fatalities have been confirmed at the scene.
- We are coordinating additional ambulances as resource demand increases due to the ongoing fire.

Jordan,

Current status at the Sherwin Williams site: Our teams have contained the initial explosion at the meth lab front; however, the fire remains active and is spreading into two adjacent commercial buildings. The additional fuel load from paper products and other combustible materials in these structures is complicating our containment efforts. We have deployed extra engines, aerial water drop units, and rescue teams to manage the situation. Regional support has been requested for additional water supply and manpower.

We will continue to provide hourly updates as the situation evolves.
